I. Quarterly Highlights – 3rd Quarter

- CBSFA attended the Public Hearing on August 27,2002 for the 2003-2005 CDP applications and a private meeting with the State CDQ oversight team on August 28,2002.
- Newly purchased 60-ton Grove crane and hydraulic boat trailer put to use supporting local vessel launch and retrieval needs.
- The CDQ halibut fishery was in full swing with the fishermen reporting lower catch rates compared to past seasons.
- The local fleet deployed Water Data Recorder units on their longline anchors to gather data on local waters for research in coordination with the IPHC.
- CBSFA held Special Board of Directors meetings on August 18th and September 18th, 2002.
- CBSFC held a Special Board of Directors meeting on August 9, 2002.
- CBSFA held a local fishermen's meeting on September 18, 2002.

II. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

A. PROGRESS TOWARD MULTI-SPECIES GOALS, OBJECTIVES, PROJECTS, AND MILESTONES

Goal 1: Develop the Small Boat Harbor (SBH)

Objective: Actively represent local fishermen’s interests in the construction, funding and operation of this regional project.

Milestone 1: Continue Local Share Set-Aside program

Status: CBSFA is continuing to save money toward the development of a small boat harbor on St. Paul Island. Ongoing.

Milestone 2: Continue efforts to seek additional Local Share funding

Status: Ongoing.

Milestone 3: Facilitate efforts to secure multi-entity uplands access agreement

Status: Ongoing.

Milestone 4: Seek State and Federal approval to accelerate ramp construction

Status: During Q1 2002, CBSFA purchased a 60-ton Grove crane to launch and retrieve our local fleet vessels and floating docks. This acquisition eliminates the need for accelerated ramp construction.

Milestone 5: Pending approval, construct ramp during summer 2001 season

Status: Acquisition of the 60-ton crane eliminates the need for accelerated ramp construction.

Milestone 6: Develop SBH Business Plan that includes long-term O & M funding options

Status: This is now being done as part of the larger MSD project.

Goal 2: Support Development of St. Paul Harbor Based Projects

Objective: Identify opportunities and make strategic investments and allocations decisions

Milestone 1: Negotiate deployment of shore-based processor at City dock

Status: We are currently pursuing this as part of the MSD project

Milestone 2: Conduct Multi Species Development Study (MSD Study)

Status: In January 2002 MSD report and project development proposal was completed. It has now been approved by the board.

Milestone 3: Short list opportunities, conduct due diligence

Status: During Q2 several Non-Disclosure Agreements were signed, and negotiations are proceeding on schedule.

Milestone 4: *Make final determination, develop business plans and make investment or allocation decisions consistent with MSD Study.*

Status: The preliminary business plan has been approved by the board and the MSD project is proceeding.

Goal 3: Direct Investment in Strategic Fisheries & Vertical Industries

Objective: Economic growth and diversification by expanding our active participation in strategic fisheries.

Project 3A: American Seafoods Company

Milestone 1: *Monitor and participate in ASC Board activities*

Status: CBSFA at its special board meeting February 21, 2002, had a report presented to them by Bernt Bodal, via teleconference.

Milestone 2: *Strengthen CBSFA/ASC management relationship*

Status: CBSFA employee (PPM) began her internship March 11, 2002 at American Seafoods. Patience Mercurief completed the internship program on June 30, 2002.

Project 3B: Freezer / Longliner Investment

Milestone 1: *Conduct due diligence on North Cape acquisition in late 2000*

Status: Completed. The North Cape was acquired through American Seafoods investment.

Milestone 2: *Make final determination, develop Business Plan and make investment consistent with due diligence, MSD Study and other strategic guidelines.*

Status: Completed.

Project 3C: Misty Islands Seafoods

Milestone 1: *Review opportunities identified in MSD Study*

Status: Completed. MSD project is proceeding.

Milestone 2: *Short list MSD Study opportunities, conduct due diligence*

Status: Completed. MSD project is proceeding.

Milestone 3: *Make final determination, develop business plans and make investments consistent with MSD Study.*

Status: Completed. MSD project is proceeding.

Project 3D: F/V Zolotoi

Milestone 1: *Continue to seek CDQ Cod exemption*

Status: Suspended pending resolution of several partnership issues.

Milestone 2: *Continue involvement in Crab Rationalization policy initiatives*

Status: On June 10, 2002 the NPFMC voted 11-0 to adopt a “Voluntary Three Pie” crab rationalization plan that incorporates most of the provisions St. Paul was working for.

Milestone 3: *Continue involvement in Vessel Buy-back policy initiatives*

Status: The vessel buy back program has been authorized by Congress. This project completed.

Project 3E: F/V Ocean Cape

Milestone 1: *Continue to seek CDQ Cod exemption*

Status: Suspended pending resolution of several partnership issues.

Milestone 2: *Continue involvement in Crab Rationalization policy initiatives*

Status: On June 10, 2002 the NPFMC voted 11-0 to adopt a “Voluntary Three Pie” crab rationalization plan that incorporates most of the provisions St. Paul was working for.

Milestone 3: *Continue involvement in Vessel Buy-back policy initiatives*

Status: The vessel buy back program has been authorized by Congress. This project completed.

Goal 4: Development of Local Fisheries

Objective: Create support programs for the development of local fisheries.

Project 4A: Local Fleet Cod Fishery

Milestone 1: *Analyze opportunity within scope of MSD Study*

Status: Completed.

Milestone 2: *Advocate for super-exclusive local fishing zone in Pribilofs*

Status: Ongoing.

Milestone 3: *Create or revise programs and amend CDP as necessary to support development of Local Fleet Cod Fishery consistent with MSD Study.*

Status: On-going analysis within MSD feasibility/pro forma project.

Project 4B: Vessel & Gear Loans, IFQ Loans, Business Loans

Milestone 1: *Annually review loan performance, program policies and budgets*

Status: Ongoing.

Milestone 2: *Analyze Loan Program structure and make strategic recommendations to Board*

Status: Ongoing.

Milestone 3: *Implement Board-approved recommendations, if any*

Status: Ongoing.

Project 4C: Local Fleet Halibut Fishery

Milestone 1: *Review success of 2000 CDQ halibut fishery and review associated programs and policies*

Status: Completed.

Milestone 2: *Analyze additional Area 4 halibut opportunities within scope of MSD Study*

Status: Completed.

Milestone 3: *Create or revise programs and amend CDP as necessary to support continued development of Local Fleet Halibut Fishery and funding of Local Fleet Support Programs consistent with MSD Study and SBH Business Plan.*

Status: We are currently tracking CIFQ and class A Share issues to define new opportunity. CBSFA has been working with IPHC on conducting halibut research involving local boats deploying water temperature data recorders this fishing season. At the October 2002 NPFMC meeting held in Seattle, CBSFA management introduced our CIFQ project to the council.

Milestone 4: *Annually conduct Halibut CDQ Fishery Management Plan meeting with local fleet*

Status: The 2002 annual fishermen's meeting was held May 23, 2002, at this meeting the local fishermen approved the 2002 Halibut CDQ fishery management plan. CBSFA held a meeting with the local fishermen on September 18, 2002 to discuss the progress of CDQ halibut fishing.

Project 4D: Vessel Support Program

Milestone 1: *Until SBH completion, annually deploy and retrieve floating dock system*

Status: CBSFA hired 8 residents to deploy the floating docks; the docks were completed June 14, 2002. Two local residents were hired as security guards to monitor the floating dock and vessels during the CDQ halibut season.

Milestone 2: *Provide Vessel Launch and Retrieval services consistent with Local Fleet needs.*

Status: CBSFA held a training class, that trained 6 members to operate the Grove RT760E 60-ton crane. CBSFA has hired one trained resident to operate and maintain the crane. Also, CBSFA received a new hydraulic boat trailer in June 2002 to be used by local fleet. The hydraulic crane and both trailers have been used on numerous occasions throughout the halibut season to assist fishermen.

Project 4E: Acquire Vessel Launch & Retrieval System

Milestone 1: *Take action consistent with CY 2000 due diligence and progress of Small Boat Harbor project.*

Status: Completed.

Milestone 2: *Conduct search for purchase of new system (crane).*

Status: Completed. CBSFA staff completed the search to purchase a crane in the first quarter of 2002. The crane is now in operation on St. Paul Island. Crane activities include the launching and retrieval of the floating docks and local fishing vessels. Different capacity cranes were analyzed and tested at Coast Crane Company in Anchorage and it was determined that a crane with a 60-ton capacity was sufficient to meet out local fleet support needs.

Milestone 3: *Seek Board review and approval of purchase.*

Status: Completed. The CBSFA board approved resolution 02-03: A resolution of the CBSFA board of directors approving the purchase of a Grove Crane Model RT 760 E (60-ton capacity).

Milestone 4: *Deploy new Vessel Launch/Retrieval system.*

Status: Completed. The newly purchased crane arrived in St. Paul at the end of April, in time for use during fishing season. The hydraulic boat trailer arrived in June, and is currently in use. Both the crane and new hydraulic trailer have received use consistently throughout 3rd quarter.

Project 4F: Vessel Repair & Maintenance Program

Milestone 1: *Annually conduct a Local Fleet Needs Assessment*

Status: Ongoing.

Milestone 2: *Issue RFP and conduct program if local needs warrant*

Status: CBSFA facilitated vessel engine maintenance and repair project (via Coastal Marine Engine mechanic) prior to the halibut season. CBSFA sponsored an AMSEA Marine Safety Training, the week of June 9th, a total of 59 fishermen participated in the training.

Project 4G: Acquire Vessel Repair & Maintenance Facility

Milestone 1: *Finalize building plan including construction finance, land acquisition and operations by Q1 2001.*

Status: Ongoing. During quarter four of 2001, CBSFA received the final conceptual design for the new vessel repair facility on St. Paul and the construction cost estimate from Polarconsultant Alaska, Inc.

Milestone 2: *Contingent upon securing land, permits and financing, begin construction by Spring 2002.*

Status: For budgeting and analysis purposes, this project has now been folded into the MSD project.

Goal 5: Education and Outreach Project

Objective: Create programs that lead to the training, education and employment of our residents.

Project 5A: Student Loans, Scholarships & Training Grants

Milestone 1: *CBSFA will fund a scholarship and student loan program*

Status: Deadline for the Fall Semester scholarship and loan applications was June 30,2002. The CBSFA Loan Committee held a meeting on August 6, 2002 to review current loans, loan applications and scholarship applications. 13 scholarships and 2 student loans were approved and awarded.

Milestone 2: *Annually review loan performance*

Status: CBSFC Loan Committee will meet in August 2002 to review all student loans.

Milestone 3: *Annually review loan and scholarship policies and budgets*

Status: The CBSFC loan committee reviewed the budget for the year 2002

Project 5B: Outreach Program

Milestone 1: *Continue quarterly newsletter*

Status: CBSFA distributed to the community of St. Paul the Quarter 2, Volume 3, issue 2, on June 28, 2002. Composition of publication "Report to the Community" in progress in place of the 3rd quarter newsletter.

Milestone 2: *Continue annual community survey*

Status: CBSFA conducted a board survey on May 13, 2002. CBSFA conducted a community survey May 13-16, 2002.

Goal 6: Investment Fund Policies & Procedures

Objective: Invest excess or held funds in a prudent manner to generate additional income to support programs and projects.

Project: Investment Fund Management

Milestone 1: *Annually review policies and procedures for general accounts*

Status: On going. CBSFA President has been corresponding with other investment institutions and seeking proposals.

Goal 7: Administrative Policies & Procedures

Objective: Continue to develop board and management expertise, and make efficient use of resources.

Milestone 1: *Continue to implement approved Management Review recommendations*

Status: Ongoing.

Milestone 2: *Annually secure independent financial & performance audits*

Status: The 2001 audit was completed May 31, 2002.

Milestone 3: *Provide updated Board training and education each year*

Status: Completed.

Milestone 4: *Annually review management performance, organization and projects*

Status: Ongoing.

Milestone 5: *Annually review partner(s) performance.*

Status: Ongoing.

Milestone 6: *Annually establish Staff Training plan and budget.*

Status: Rena J. Kudrin worked on the second quarter financials with Jason Lee at Altman, Rogers & Co. in July. Patience Mercurief completed her internship with American Seafoods, June 30, 2002.

Milestone 7: *Periodically review Strategic Plan and Five-Year Financial Forecast*

Status: Ongoing.

Milestone 8: *Participate in NPFMC, IPHC, ABOF and other appropriate policy making forums.*

Status: CBSFA President, Phillip Lestenkof and Quota Manager, Patience Mercurief, attended the NPFMC, held in Anchorage April 2002.
CBSFA President Phillip Lestenkof and Chairman Myron Melovidov, attended the NPFMC, held in Dutch Harbor, June 2002.
CBSFA attended the Public Hearing in August for the 2003-2005 CDP Application.

Milestone 9: *Annually establish Community Program plan and budget.*

Status: CBSFA conducted a community survey in May 2002, and was determined that vessel engine repair and maintenance was needed. As a result, CBSFA facilitated engine repair and maintenance project by bring an engine mechanic from Costal Maine Engine to St. Paul, to work on local vessels prior to the fishing season.

In place of the 3rd quarter newsletter CBSFA is completing a “Report to the Community,” for distribution is late October or early November.

CBSFA sent one application to American Seafoods Company for employment during the Pollock A/B Season.
