

**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF EMERGENCY REGULATIONS OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, COMMUNITY, AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**

On March 10, 2011, the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development adopted, as emergency regulations, changes in Title 3 of the Alaska Administrative Code dealing with a community revenue sharing program, including the following:

Chapter 180 is being amended under 3 AAC regarding provisions addressing population determination procedures and release date of program applications.

The emergency regulations took effect March 10, 2011, and will expire July 7, 2011.
