NCEES EXAM ADMINISTRATION: NCEES (formerly ELSES) began administering the NCEES exams in October 2006. You must still apply to the Division of Corporations, Business & Professional Licensing for approval to sit for the exams. If you are approved your name will be submitted to NCEES as an eligible candidate. You must then register and pay for the exam at the NCEES web site: www.ncees.org/examadministration/. The Division will be collecting only the nonrefundable application fee.

EXAMINATION APPLICATION DEADLINE: The application form, all supporting documents and nonrefundable application fee must be received by the Division's Juneau Office by the deadline date, which is 10 days before each regularly scheduled board meeting. (**The completed application must be typed and notarized.**) A board meeting schedule is available on this web site.

RETAKE A FAILED EXAM: The Division charges no fee for retaking a failed examination (except the AKLS exam fee), however, you will be required to pay the examination fee to NCEES. If you fail an exam and wish a retake, you must contact the division so we can verify that you are still eligible. Your name will then be provided to NCEES and you must register and pay for the exam at the NCEES web site: www.ncees.org/examadministration/

To retake a failed exam in October you must submit a written (fax and email are acceptable) request to the Division's Juneau office by September 1. To retake a failed exam in April you must submit a written request to the Division's Juneau office by February 20. These dates remain the same for all years.

AKLS EXAMINATION: The division will continue to administer the AKLS in April of each year. Out of state proctoring will no longer be allowed.
