SUBJECT: Investigative Report for the June 26, 2009 meeting

The Board of Chiropractic Examiners has one open investigation, six open complaints, and two licensees on probation. In the past three years, this investigator opened 271 complaints and investigations, closed 270 matters, and reviewed an additional 182 applications not amounting to complaints or investigations, approximately 12 percent of those were chiropractic matters.
