BIENNIAL SOCIAL WORKER LICENSE RENEWAL
July 1, 2010 – June 30, 2012

IT IS TIME TO RENEW YOUR SOCIAL WORKER LICENSE

Your license to practice as a social worker in the State of Alaska expires on June 30, 2010. There is no grace period. To renew your license for the period from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2012, return this signed, notarized application to the above address with a check or money order payable to the State of Alaska. You can also pay by credit card (see attached form.) This is the only renewal notice that you will receive. Incomplete applications or insufficient fees will result in your renewal being rejected. DO NOT FAX.

RENEWAL DUE DATE – If you have met the continuing competency requirements (see attached regulation), complete this form and return with the appropriate fee for processing. The processing time for correct and completed renewal applications is three to four weeks after receipt. Plan accordingly and submit your form as soon as possible to ensure processing by the expiration date of June 30, 2010. Please allow additional time for processing if you answer "yes" to any of the professional fitness questions.

EXPIRED LICENSES – There is no "inactive" license status. If you choose not to renew your license before it expires, you may renew the license at a later date only after satisfying the requirements in Article 2 of 12 AAC 18. Licenses which have expired more than five years cannot be renewed.

SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS – In accordance with AS 08.01.100(e), the department is not authorized to renew a license unless the applicant's social security number has been provided to the department. If you do not have a social security number, you can download the "Request for exception from Social Security Number," form 08-4373, from the division's website at www.commerce.state.ak.us/occ or contact this office for the form to be mailed to you. If you previously qualified for a waiver to this requirement, you must requalify for a waiver to renew.

PAYMENT OF CHILD SUPPORT AND STUDENT LOANS - If the Alaska Child Support Enforcement Division has determined that you are in arrears on child support, or if the Alaska Commission on Post-Secondary Education has determined you are in loan default, you may be issued a nonrenewable temporary license valid for 150 days. Contact Child Support Services at (907) 269-6900 or the Post-Secondary Education office at (907) 465-2962 or 1-800-441-2962 to resolve payment issues.

PUBLIC INFORMATION – Please be aware that all information on this renewal form will be available to the public, unless required to be kept confidential by state or federal law. Information about current licenses, including mailing addresses, is available on the division's website at: www.commerce.state.ak.us/occ under "License Search."

CONTINUING EDUCATION

Your license cannot be renewed unless you have met the continuing education requirements in Article 2 of 12 AAC 18. (See attached regulations).

RANDOM AUDIT: A percentage of license renewal applications will be randomly selected for audit. If selected, you must submit copies of certificates or other acceptable proof that you satisfied the continuing education requirements as you have stated on this application. You are required to save your documents for at least three years, so you can respond to audits. Licensees unable to comply with the audit are subject to disciplinary license action.

You may not claim hours for education not yet successfully completed as of the date of submitting this application. Per 12 AAC 02.960(j) "successfully completed" means C.E. credit has been awarded.

NOTE: Of the 45 contact hours of continuing education required, a minimum of six contact hours need to be in the area of substance abuse education and three hours in professional ethics. For first time renewals, a minimum of six hours in cross-cultural education relating to Alaska Natives is required. For second time renewals, a minimum of six hours in cross-cultural education, at least three hours of which relate to Alaska Natives is required. Additional information is provided with this renewal with a copy of the regulations. In the table below, the categories for hours are broken down as follows: G – General continuing education hours; S – Substance Abuse hours; CC – Cross-Cultural hours; AK – Alaska Native Specific; CC/S – both Cross-Cultural and Substance Abuse (i.e., Cross-Cultural and Substance Abuse hours can be combined as long as the continuing education subject covers both areas); and P – Professional Ethics.

Only Hours earned between July 1, 2008 and June 30, 2010 may be accepted for this renewal.

LICENSE RENEWAL AND CONTINUING EDUCATION

12 AAC 18.200. LICENSE RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS. An applicant for renewal of a license under this chapter shall

- (1) complete a renewal application on a form provided by the department;
- (2) pay the license renewal fee established in 12 AAC 02.155; and
- (3) submit a sworn statement of the continuing education contact hours completed during the concluding licensing period, which must include the following information, when applicable, for each course, seminar, or workshop:
 - (A) the name of the sponsoring organization;
 - (B) the location of the course, seminar, or workshop;
 - (C) the title or a brief description of the course, seminar, or workshop;
 - (D) the principal instructor;
 - (E) the dates of attendance;
 - (F) the titles, issues, and dates of publications or presentations; and
 - (G) the number of continuing education contact hours claimed.

12 AAC 18.210. CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENT. (a) For the first biennial renewal of a person's social worker license, an applicant for renewal shall document completion of 45 contact hours of continuing education activities acceptable to the board that were earned during the two years before the expiration date of the person's license that included a minimum of

- (1) six contact hours in substance abuse education;
 - (2) six contact hours in cross-cultural education relating to Alaska Natives; and
 - (3) three contact hours in professional ethics.
- (b) After a person's first biennial renewal of a social worker license, an applicant for renewal shall document completion of 45 contact hours of continuing education activities acceptable to the board that were earned during that licensing period and included a minimum of
- (1) six contact hours in substance abuse education;
 - (2) six contact hours in cross-cultural education, of which three hours include issues relating to Alaska Natives; and
 - (3) three contact hours in professional ethics.
- (c) For the purposes of this section,
- (1) one "contact hour" equals a minimum of 50 minutes of classroom instruction between instructor and participant;
 - (2) one academic semester credit equals 15 contact hours; and
 - (3) one academic quarter credit equals 10 contact hours.
- (d) Only hours of actual attendance during which instruction was given will be accepted as continuing education contact hours earned from an academic course that is audited by the licensee, and the total number of contact hours earned may not exceed the academic credit hours offered for that course.

12 AAC 18.220. APPROVED CONTINUING EDUCATION ACTIVITIES. (a) To be accepted by the board, continuing education must contribute directly to the professional competency of a social worker and must be directly related to the skills and knowledge required to implement social work principles and methods as defined in AS 08.95.990.

(b) The following continuing education activities are acceptable if they are related to social work in accordance with (a) of this section:

- (1) postgraduate courses in social work given by an academic institution either audited or for credit;
- (2) courses offered by or certified by the Association of Social Work Boards;
- (3) courses offered by or certified by the National Association of Social Workers or any state chapter of the National Association of Social Workers.
- (4) courses offered by a program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education;
- (5) seminars, workshops, or mini-courses offered by professional organizations;
- (6) cross-disciplinary courses, seminars, or workshops in the fields of medicine, law, behavioral sciences, or other disciplines;
- (7) other courses not covered under (1) – (6) of this subsection that are specifically preapproved by the board, up to a maximum of 15 contact hours;
- (8) first-time preparation and presentation of a social work course, seminar, or workshop, up to a maximum of 10 contact hours allocated among all social workers and other professionals involved; and
- (9) first time presentation or publication of an article or book chapter related to the practice of social work that was presented at a state or national association meeting or published by a publisher recognized by the profession, up to a maximum of 10 contact hours allocated among all social workers and other professionals involved.

(c) Hours spent in job orientation may not be accepted as continuing education contact hours.

12 AAC 18.230. AUDIT OF CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS. (a) After each renewal period the board will, in its discretion, audit renewal applications to monitor compliance with the continuing education requirements of this chapter.

(b) A licensee selected for audit shall, within 30 days from the date of notification, submit documentation to verify completion of the contact hours claimed under 12 AAC 18.210.

(c) An applicant for renewal is responsible for maintaining adequate and detailed records of all continuing education hours claimed and shall make them available to the board upon request under this section. Records must be retained for three years after the date the continuing hours were earned.
