APPLICATION FOR REGISTERED GUIDE-OUTFITTER EXAMINATION

PLEASE READ THE INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE COMPLETING THE APPLICATION. ANY PORTION OF THE APPLICATION THAT IS NOT SUBMITTED OR COMPLETED WILL DELAY PROCESSING.

A natural person is entitled to a Registered Guide-Outfitter license if the person

- is 21 years of age;
- has been licensed as and performed the services of a Class-A Assistant Guide or Assistant Guide, or a Class-A Assistant Guide-Outfitter or Assistant Guide-Outfitter in Alaska for a part of each of three years for a total of 125 days "in field" guiding experience;
- has legally hunted big game in Alaska for a part of any five years in a manner directly contributing to the person's experience and competency as a guide;
- has been favorably recommended in writing by eight big game hunters, including at least two favorable recommendations for each year of any three years during which the person was a Class-A Assistant Guide or Assistant Guide, or a Class-A Assistant Guide-Outfitter or Assistant Guide-Outfitter;
- meets the eligibility requirements set out in AS 08.54.605 (page 3);

Items 1-5 below must be postmarked at least 120 days before the date of the next scheduled Registered Guide-Outfitter qualification examination. Failure to have items 1-5 submitted by the examination deadline date will result in you not being considered for scheduling of the Registered Guide-Outfitter qualification examination. NO EXCEPTIONS.

1. A check or money order payable to the State of Alaska as follows:
 - \$50.00 application fee (nonrefundable).
 - \$50.00 Registered Guide-Outfitter qualification examination fee.
 - \$50.00 (per unit, maximum 3 units) Game Management Unit Certification examination fee.
 - \$450.00 resident license fee (not required until after applicant has passed examination).
 - \$950.00 non-resident license fee (not required until after applicant has passed examination).
2. Complete, notarized or postmaster stamped application.
3. Complete "Authorization and Release" form.
4. A list of hunters for whom you have provided big game hunting services in compliance with Alaska Statute 08.54.610(a)(8).
5. Class-A Assistant/Assistant Guide Evaluation 08-4013c.

Items 6-8 below must be postmarked at least 45 days before the date of the next scheduled Registered Guide-Outfitter qualification examination. Failure to have items 6-8 submitted by the 45 day examination deadline date will result in you not being considered for scheduling of the Registered Guide-Outfitter qualification examination. NO EXCEPTIONS.

6. Each applicant is to submit a complete report of criminal justice information under AS 12.62 for Alaska, to include fish and wildlife violations. The Alaska report can be obtained by contacting the Department of Public Safety, Alaska Wildlife Troopers at any of the following locations on page 5 and 6.

In addition to the Alaska reports, if a state other than Alaska is your primary state of residence you must submit an equivalent report, to include fish and wildlife violations from your state of residency. Nonresident applicants will need to contact your state troopers' office to obtain a complete report of criminal justice information.

7. Verification of licensure status from each state, or Canadian jurisdiction, where you hold or have held a license to provide guiding, outfitting, transportation, or other hunting services license, if any, which is to be submitted directly to the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing from the issuing government body.
8. Affidavit of Flying Experience. If you personally pilot an aircraft to transport clients during the provisions of the big game commercial hunting services, you must show proof of a current commercial pilot's license or 500 hours of flying time in Alaska (AS 08.54.680(b)).

It is unlawful for a person to guide without having a current valid big game guide license and hunting licensing in actual possession.

EXAMINATIONS

The Registered Guide-Outfitter qualification examination are given twice a year and Game Management Unit Certification examinations are given quarterly. A score of 75 percent or higher is passing.

An applicant will not be scheduled to sit for the guide examinations until the requirements of 1 through 8 have been submitted and the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing has received the required recommendations stated in 4 of page 1.

Registered Guide-Outfitter Qualification examination consists of a written examination and includes a practical examination covering:

- ❖ trophy judging of actual antlers and horns using the Boone and Crockett or Safari Club International scoring process;
- ❖ aging of animals;
- ❖ sexing of mountain goats and bears; and
- ❖ caping a big game animal; for this portion of the examination the applicant must provide a visual recording of the applicant caping a big game animal. Note: The applicant's hands and face must be seen at all times. §Visual Recording Instructions can be obtained on-line at www.commerce.state.ak.us/occ/pgui.htm under the "Examinations" link.
- ❖ Visual recording must be submitted no later than the examination date for which you are scheduled.

Game Management Unit Certification examination will test the applicant's knowledge on terrain, game, geography, transportation, logistics, and land ownership.

BE ADVISED

The Big Game Commercial Services Board will seek maximum penalties of big game commercial services license holders who are found to have violated a hunting, guiding, outfitting, and/or transportation services statute and/or regulation.

ELIGIBILITY FOR LICENSES (AS 08.54.605)

- (a) A person may not receive a registered guide-outfitter license if
- (1) the person has been convicted of
 - (A) a violation of a state or federal hunting, guiding, or transportation services statute or regulation for which
 - (i) the person was imprisoned for more than five days within the previous five years;
 - (ii) an unsuspended fine of more than \$2,000 was imposed in the previous 12 months;
 - (iii) an unsuspended fine of more than \$3,000 was imposed in the previous 36 months;
 - (iv) or an unsuspended fine of more than \$5,000 was imposed in the previous 60 months;
 - (B) a felony within the last five years; or
 - (C) a felony offense against the person under AS 11.41 within the last 10 years; or
 - (2) the person's right to obtain, or exercise the privileges granted by, a hunting, guiding, outfitting, or transportation services license is suspended or revoked in this state or another state or in Canada.

DEFINITIONS

Natural Person, means a living, breathing human, as opposed to a legal entity such as a corporation.

Resident, According to AS 16.05.940(27), "**resident**" means a person who for the 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the time when the assertion of residence is made has maintained the person's domicile in the state and who is neither claiming residency in another state, territory, or country nor obtaining benefits under a claim of residency in another state, territory, or country; a partnership, association, joint stock company, trust, or corporation that has its main office or headquarters in the state; a natural person who does not otherwise qualify as a resident under this paragraph may not qualify as a resident by virtue of an interest in a partnership, association, joint stock company, trust, or corporation; a member of the military service, or United States Coast Guard, who has been stationed in the state for the 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the time when the assertion of residence is made; a person who is the dependent of a resident member of the military service, or the United States Coast Guard, and who has lived in the state for the 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the time when the assertion of residence is made; or an alien who for the 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the time when the assertion of residence is made has maintained the person's domicile in the state and who is neither claiming residency in another state, territory, or country nor obtaining benefits under a claim of residency in another state, territory, or country.

Responsibility of Violations

A registered guide-outfitter who contracts to guide or outfit a big game hunt is equally responsible for violations of a state or federal wildlife game, guiding, or transportation services' statutes or regulations committed by a person while in the course of the person's employment for the registered guide-outfitter (AS 08.54.740).

Law Enforcement Officers

If you are a fish and game law enforcement officer for the State of Alaska, United States Department of the Interior or the United States Department of Agriculture, you may not hold or earn experience credits to apply for a Registered Guide-Outfitter license while you are a law enforcement officer and for three months after termination status as a law enforcement officer (AS 08.54.640 (a)).

Game Biologists

A person who holds any class of guide license and who is employed by the Department of Fish and Game or a federal wildlife management agency may not, while employed by the department or agency as a game or wildlife biologist and for 12 months after leaving employment with the department or agency as a game management or wildlife biologist, engage in providing big game hunting services in a game management unit in which the person conducted game or wildlife management or research activities for the department of agency at any time during the preceding 12 months (AS 08.54.640(c)).

GENERAL INFORMATION

Social Security Numbers

Alaska Statutes (AS) 08.01.060(b) and 08.01.100(e) require an applicant for an occupational license to provide a United States Social Security Number. However, if you do not have a social security number issued to you, you may qualify for an exception. Contact the Division and request a "Request for Exception from Social Security Number Requirement" (Form 08-4372) to be mailed to you or obtain from the Division webpage at: www.commerce.state.ak.us/occ. If you qualify for a license without a social security number, you will be required at each renewal to complete the form and mail it with your renewal application. Contact the Division at the address noted on this application.

Renewal

Renewal notices are mailed at least 30 days prior to the license expiration. It is the licensee's responsibility to ensure renewal of the license. Please contact the Division if you have a change of address. Failure to receive a renewal notice does not excuse nonrenewal.

Americans with Disabilities Act

Programs under the jurisdiction of the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are administered in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you require a special accommodation when taking the licensing examination, you must submit a complete **Request for Accommodation** form which is available upon request or may be obtained at: www.commerce.state.ak.us/occ/. Requests for special accommodations must be received on or before the stated application deadline.

Abandonment

Under 12 AAC 02.910, an application is considered abandoned when 12 months have elapsed since correspondence was last received from or on behalf of the applicant. An abandoned application is denied without prejudice and the application fee is forfeited.

Payment of Child Support and Student Loans

If the Alaska Child Support Enforcement Division has determined that you are in arrears on child support, or in the Alaska Commission on Post-Secondary Education has determined you are in loan default, you will be issued a nonrenewable temporary license valid for 150 days. Contact Child Support Enforcement at (907) 269-6657 if your last name begins with A through M; contact (907) 269-6845 if your last name begins with N through Z, or 1-800-478-3300. Contact the Post Secondary Education office at 1-888-441-2961 to resolve payment issues.
